The Islamic Republic of Iran welcomes the distinguished high-level delegation of the Republic of Maldives to this fourth cycle of the Universal Periodic Review and expresses appreciation for its comprehensive national report and presentation.

The Islamic Republic of Iran commends the Maldives for its ongoing efforts to enhance labor conditions, notably through the establishment of a labor-management information system and the review of the national minimum wage framework.

First: to further explore avenues for the promotion and realization of the right to development, including through strengthened South-South cooperation and effective implementation of the Declaration on the Right to Development;
